Moss & Barnett salutes family law practice area co-chair **Susan Rhode** for being selected to present a report on gender fairness in the family law arena at “Gender Fairness in the Courts - A 20 Year Retrospective” on October 27, 2009. The report addressed the progress made and areas in need of additional work since the Minnesota Supreme Court’s historic report chronicling gender bias issues in the justice system in September 1989.

Susan also was recently appointed by the Minnesota Supreme Court to Chair the Fourth Judicial District Bar Association’s Ethics Committee, effective April 19, 2010. The Fourth Judicial District includes all of Hennepin County. District Ethics Committees are established in each of the 21 district bar associations to investigate complaints of unethical conduct against Minnesota lawyers for the State Lawyers Professional Responsibility Board.

In addition, Susan recently was named the “Minneapolis *Best Lawyer’s* Family Lawyer of the Year” for 2010. Only a single lawyer in each specialty in each community is being honored as a “Lawyer of the Year.” A lawyer being honored as a “Lawyer of the Year” has received particularly high ratings in the *Best Lawyers* surveys by earning a high level of respect among their peers for their abilities, professionalism, and integrity.
